John 15:4 - Remain in Me, and I in you.

John 8:31-32 - So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed Him, "If you continue in My word, you really are My disciples. You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

Fourth, we abide in loving others

John 15:10 - If you keep My commands you will remain in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commands and remain in His love.

John 15:17 - This is what I command you: Love one another.

Prayer, Communion, Scripture and Service are ways of abiding in that they all declare the love of God found in Christ.
